# Steinway Society 2008 Scholarship Competition

**Eligibility:** New Jersey & Bucks County piano students who demonstrate outstanding talent and progress while pursuing excellence in performance. Previous 1st prize winners may not compete again in the same age group. Contestants should not be related to, or students of Judges, Artistic Advisors, Board members or employees of Jacobs Music.

**Deadline:** **Applications must be delivered or mailed by March 10, 2008.**

Late applications will not be accepted.

**Entrance Fee:** Payable to Steinway Society (non-refundable):\*

Group 1:	Age 7- 9 (Min. 2 years of study)	\$35
Group 2:	Age 10-12	\$40
Group 3:	Age 13-15	\$45
Group 4:	Age 16-18	\$50

\* Fee may be waived in cases of financial hardship.

**Preliminary Audition:** Submit an application along with an audio CD (strongly preferred) or tape of two contrasting works from different historical periods along with the application fee. Include a brief biographical statement and a teacher recommendation. All CDs and tapes will be heard anonymously and critiqued by a panel of accredited musicians in the field of piano pedagogy and performance artistry. The names and qualifications of the judges will be posted at a later date on the Steinway Society website: <http://www.princetonol.com/groups/steinway>.

**Final Audition:** On April 5, 2008, three judges will audition the finalists who will perform from memory their two contrasting solo compositions. Please provide an original score of each composition (no photocopies) for use by the judges. Winner placements will be announced.

**Awards:** Winners will perform one composition chosen by the judges and receive their awards during the Scholarship Musicale on May 4, 2008. Judges reserve the right not to award scholarships in all categories; their decision will be final. Photographs will be taken following the musicale. Having participated as a winner, you consent to the use of your name and photograph in connection with Steinway Society publicity.
