Zaire Found in Ruins of Pentagon

KABUL, Sept. 20 — Long thought dead, the notorious A. G. Zaire may be alive, sources in Afghanistan said today. Witnesses reported an ashen figure crawling from under the Pentagon debris wearing a flak jacket with the letters "AGZ" clearly discernable on the back. No one answering to any of Zaire's numerous descriptions has come forth, but this lack of confirmation is not thought unusual by those close to recent events in Washington. A search of many nearby hospitals and bars did not yield any results.

Although little is known of the details of Zaire's demise, reported in these pages a year and a half ago, scepticism had been expressed by several close associates. One of them, who refused to give any name other than "Jorge," said, "Not one person who knew Zaire really believed he could be dead. And a year and a half is a long time for someone to be dead anyway, let alone Zaire." It is not known what this last statement means.

Another reputed associate, Ms. Dorothy P. Reau-Jeau, refused extensive comment, and merely smiled and said, as she packed her bags, "See ya later, Minor Tom."

Experts are divided on the international impact of this news. However, if Zaire is really alive, events great and small all over the world are expected to be affected. For example, Taliban officials were seen fortifying their caves in anticipation of swift retribution for what Zaire will see as a personal attack on himself. "Bush, we can deal with, that's no big problem," said one high-ranking mullah, "but Zaire is another matter
