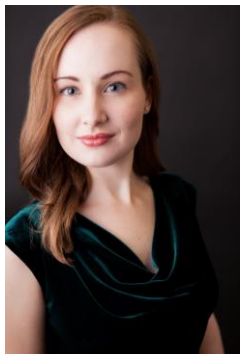


Sarah Stine
