Gift-A-Book to Stony Brook Library How Can I Gift-A-Book? It's so EASY!!!

FIRST:

Look at a DONATOR FORM for Gift-A-Book to Stony Brook Library to become familiar with your choices.

SECOND (make your choice of the following ways to gift-a-book from the DONATOR FORM):
CHOICES:

- A. Choose a book from the Stony Brook Library Gift-A-Book Cart *(usually located on the right wall when you enter the library unless it has been moved to a special Gift-A-Book Area during certain special events)* (the price of each book is marked inside the book); or
- B. Let the Library choose a book with your monetary donation; or
- C. Choose a book from Ms. Mattison's Library Wish List; or
- D. Purchase a NEW CURRENT HARD BACK BOOK ("library ready" if possible) to donate to the Stony Brook Library.

THIRD:

Fill out the DONATOR FORM for Gift-a-Book to Stony Brook Library.

FOURTH:

Make your check payable to the Stony Brook PTO in the appropriate amount.

FIFTH:

Return your paperwork and payment to Ms. Mattison in the Stony Brook Library or Gift-a-Book Chair, Liz Gambino.
